MISSION

The Tax Observatory democratizes the information about public finance in Colombia in order for the citizenship to fight against corruption and the misuse of public resources through a well informed vote and civil activism.

It intends to socialize public finances to the society and it articulates the strengths of the Economic and Administrative Sciences School, the JSG and the Javeriana community.

ACTIONS

Strengthening exchange strategies for professors and students.

Creation of a web portal to facilitate the exchange of information, virtual mobility and internationalization

Participation of the governing bodies in associations specific to each University (such as Alumni Associations) to strengthen inter-institutional links and cooperation.

Inter-institutional agreements for foreign language training

Definition of thematic axes or training lines through the Chair

Enable joint publications.

Organize forums, seminars, workshops and inter-institutional conversations.

JOINT PUBLICATIONS



Joint publications with national and international strategic partners



BILINGUALISM

Events around the thematic axes of the EJG in English. Developed with experts from Faculties or Institutes of the university or from universities abroad. Reaching a wider audience and giving visibility to the School.





MEET THE CAMPUS

Invitations to potential allies to get to know the University Campus and the Javeriana School of Government and Public Ethic (JSG).





TIKTOK

Creation of a TikTok account to post short videos (10 seconds long) of events, activities, posts (among others) to impact students and younger audiences in general.

BLOG

Creation of a blog space, open to students, professors and partners to receive articles, publications, opinion columns (among others) on the themes of the JSG.





PODCAST

Creation of a podcast of the JSG to have a space where interviews and short dialogues can be carried out on events, publications and current topics of national interest on the thematic axes of the JSG with expert guests.

Podcasts are timeless, easily accessible, and appealing to a different audience, more audio-oriented than reading-oriented. This diversifies the JSG portfolio and makes it visible in other spheres.

Likewise, podcasts can strengthen bilingualism, by developing certain chapters in English.



ATTAINMENT OF RESOURCES

EJG has very important national allies such as Ecopetrol, Bancolombia, Airbnb, Alquilería (among others) that have contributed with events, workshops, training, consulting and improvement plans to strengthen transparency and public ethics in society.

Currently, EJG is developing the ESG criteria program for the Bancolombia Foundation.

EJG wants to continue growing and providing opportunities for more and more people and organizations to integrate transparency and public ethics in their professional activities. We are open to new international partners to support this mission.
